HELPING PEOPLE IN SAN DIEGO

RETURNING \$2 MILLION TO SAN DIEGANS:

By helping constituents navigate the federal bureaucracy, Scott and his staff have restored more than \$2 million in benefits, like Social Security and Veterans' benefits, to San Diegans who've earned them.

INVESTING IN SAN DIEGO: Scott has secured more than \$1 billion in investments for infrastructure and job creation for San Diego.

PROTECTING OUR FAMILIES FROM GUN VIOLENCE

commonsense GUN REFORMS: Scott cosponsored a bill that strengthens background checks to keep firearms away from criminals and the dangerously mentally ill.

LEADING ON GUN SAFETY: Scott was a leader in the protest sit-in on the floor of the House of Representatives of the House of Representatives to call attention to the need for Congress to act to prevent gun violence.

STANDING UP TO THE GUN LOBBY: Scott fought against NRA-backed lawmakers to force a vote on laws that keep guns away from terrorists and domestic abusers.



FIGHTING TO PROTECT WOMEN'S HEALTH CARE

PROTECTING PLANNED PARENTHOOD: Scott is a strong supporter of women's access to affordable reproductive health, and is endorsed by the Planned Parenthood Action Fund.

ACCESS TO BIRTH CONTROL: Scott voted to stop Republican extremists from stripping away access to affordable birth control from millions of Americans.

FIXING A BROKEN CONGRESS

NO BUDGET, NO PAY: Scott voted to pass the "No Budget, No Pay" law so that when Congress doesn't do its job and pass a budget, it doesn't get a paycheck.

FIX CONGRESS NOW: Scott's created the "Fix Congress Now" Plan, a detailed pathway forward to get Congress back on track.

CUT WASTEFUL SPENDING: Scott introduced and passed bipartisan legislation to stop the government from printing unnecessary documents and reports.



TAKING CARE OF OUR MILITARY VETERANS

ZEROSHUNDRED: Scott launched zero8hundred, an organization that helps military heroes transition to civilian life, and passed legislation to support similar projects nationwide.

A LEADER ON VA REFORM: When partisan gridlock held up VA reform, Scott introduced a motion that was credited with breaking the logjam. It led to passage of a law that better connects vets to the healthcare they've earned.

HELPING VETERANS GET GOOD JOBS: Scott passed an amendment encouraging the Department of Defense to hire veterans for construction projects at places like Coronado and Miramar.

GROWING OUR INNOVATION ECONOMY

RESEARCH FUNDING: Scott was a leader in passage of an increased budget for investment in scientific research. San Diego jobs and critical healthcare breakthroughs depend on it.

support for small business: Scott passed an amendment that makes it easier for small business to compete for federal defense contracts

CLEAN ENERGY JOBS OF THE FUTURE:

Scott passed an amendment that encourages the development of innovative power plants that create energy while reducing harmful emissions.

MEDICAL DEVICE TAX: San Diego's medical device companies support thousands of good jobs. Scott led the effort to block for two years the harmful medical device excise tax that hurts R&D and job creation.



STANDING UP FOR SAN DIEGO VALUES

ADDRESSING HOMELESSNESS: Scott passed legislation to force the Department of Housing and Urban Development to change an outdated funding formula that short-changes San Diego's funding to help the homeless. An updated formula will ensure San Diego gets more of its fair share.

LGBT EQUALITY: Scott passed a bipartisan amendment that prohibits federal contractors from discriminating against LGBT Americans.
